It is our hospital policy that all canines presented for grooming or drop-off procedures in the hospital must be currently vaccinated against DA2PPv, Rabies and Bordetella and all felines against FVRCP and Rabies. ALL pets must have a current negative Intestinal Parasite exam on file. If you cannot present current vaccination records for your pet within **ONE HOUR** of drop-off, those vaccines will be administered while your pet is here in the hospital. These requirements are for the safety and protection of your pet, other pets in our facility, and our staff. Sick animals will be vaccinated only if deemed by the veterinarian to be in their best interest.

Canine influenza vaccine is recommended for our patients that will be boarding or grooming in our facility or other boarding kennels. **Do you wish to have your pet vaccinated for influenza? Yes No (Circle one)**

Lyme vaccine is recommended for those dogs that will travel to the northeast area or other endemic areas, or for those who have a very heavy tick burden.

**Do you wish to have your pet vaccinated for Lyme disease? Yes or No (Circle one)**

Leptospirosis is a disease carried by rodents, farm animals and wildlife. These animals often infect pets via urinating in areas your pet may visit. Stagnant water (ponds, slow moving creeks, etc.) may also harbor this bacteria. If your pet is exposed to the above risk factors, we recommend vaccination.
